Brief Explanation:

This circular provides background information and administrator instructions for completing the 2014-15 University of California 'a-g' update documents.

A. Background

The University of California (UC) requires schools and/or districts to update their UC 'a-g' Course Lists annually. This year, as in previous years, the Office of Accountability will update high schools' 'a-g' Course Lists for 2014–15 through a districtwide submission. Because the UC requires that a single district coordinator complete the 'a-g' update process, individual sites are not permitted to make changes on their own to their school's 'a-g' list, nor may they directly contact or submit new courses to the UC in connection with the update process. Instead, schools must work through the Office of Accountability to effect these changes.

B. Action

All district high schools with established UC 'a-g' Course Lists are asked to print, review, and complete the attached 2014–15 UC 'a-g' update documents (Attachments 2–4) and return the updated **printed copies no later than May 9, 2014** to: Karen Wilson, Planning Analyst; Office of Accountability, Room 3150, Eugene Brucker Education Center. **Please return only printed hard copies of the documents; faxed or emailed documents will not be accepted.** Sites are responsible for retaining copies of their updated 'a-g' documents and should use them to verifying the accuracy of their high school's official 2014-15 UC 'a-g' Course List once it has been published.

INSTRUCTIONS****Background**

The University of California requires high schools to update their UC ‘a-g’ Course Lists annually so that they accurately reflect the courses each school will be offering in the upcoming school year. This is done through a districtwide submission, based on information provided by schools in the attached worksheets.

Action required:

Principals are asked to update and return the following printed forms **by Monday, May 9, 2014**, to Karen Wilson, Planning Analyst, Office of Accountability, Room 3150, Eugene Brucker Education Center:

Instructions for Completing the Forms:

PRINCIPAL CERTIFICATION FORM: A signed Principal Certification Form is required for all high schools maintaining a UC ‘a-g’ Course List. Principals are accountable for the accuracy of the information that appears on their school’s UC ‘a-g’ Course List every year. Because of this, all completed 2014–15 UC ‘a-g’ update documents must be accompanied by a signed Principal Certification Form when they are returned. By signing the certification form, principals acknowledge that the course information they provide will be submitted as their school’s official UC ‘a-g’ Course List for 2014–15.

COURSE WORKSHEETS—GENERAL: Both sets of worksheets (Attachments 3 and 4) must be reviewed, updated, and returned by each site as described below in order for the school’s 2014–15 UC ‘a-g’ Course List to be activated. Except for online courses offered by iHigh Virtual Academy, UC-approved ‘a-g’ courses for 2014–15 are listed on the worksheets; therefore, please **do not write in names of courses you do not see**.

‘A-g’ course lists are year-specific and serve as a record of the course opportunities available to students at your school during each year of attendance. A course must appear on a school’s list for the year in which it was taken in order to count for ‘a-g’ credit.

Please note the following change regarding “Sheltered” course titles: With the implementation of PowerSchool, courses in the ELD sequence will no longer exist as separate entries from the grade-level course equivalents. Courses carrying “sheltered” in their titles and “L” course-number modifiers are now invalid and have been removed from the worksheet listings. Their transcript abbreviations will be automatically removed from schools’ ‘a-g’ course lists; no action is required by school sites.

Update the worksheets in the following manner, using a **blue** or **red pen**:

a) For the ‘A-G’ SUBJECT-AREA COURSE WORKSHEETS: (Attachment 3):

1. Write the name of your school at the top of each worksheet.
2. **Verify the courses currently on your school’s ‘a-g’ course list.** The worksheets reflect the courses you chose last year to put on your school’s ‘a-g’ list for the current year. The courses on the worksheets should match the courses on your school’s officially published ‘a-g’ Course List on the UC Doorways web site: <http://doorways.ucop.edu/list>. If you find any discrepancies **for the regular subject-area courses** (not AP courses), please note them in the margin of the appropriate 2014–15 worksheets along with the corrective action required. Do not include duplicate course listings.
3. **Update the worksheets with the courses you will offer in 2014–15:** All changes should be noted in the left margin next to the course number; do not change any information in the grid. If no changes are needed on a worksheet page, write “No Change” or “NC” at the top of the page and circle it. On pages where course changes are needed. Please follow these directions:
 - ▶ To **Remove** a course from next year’s a-g list (i.e., the course is not going to be offered), put a strike (line) through the course number and course title, and write ‘**D**’ (for “delete”) in the margin next to it.
 - ▶ To **Add** a course to next year’s list, circle the course number and course title and write ‘**A**’ (for “add”) in the margin next to it.

b) For the ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) COURSE WORKSHEETS (Attachment 4):

1. Write the name of your school at the top of each worksheet.
2. **Note which courses appear on the AP worksheets and your school’s published ‘a-g’ list.** The worksheets reflect only those courses that had been approved by the AP Audit for your school at the time the ‘a-g’ update cycle closed on September 15, 2013. Schools whose courses failed to get audit approval by that date will find discrepancies between the courses they have listed on the worksheets and their published ‘a-g’ course list, and the AP courses that are being taught at their school this year. Do not include these missing AP courses as discrepancies when completing the worksheets for 2014–15.
3. **Update the AP worksheets with the courses you plan to offer in 2014–15.** As with the subject-area worksheets, do not change any information in the grid; note all changes in the left margin next to the course number.
 - ▶ If you plan to **Reauthorize** an AP course previously approved through the audit, put an ‘**R**’ in the left-hand margin next to the course number.
 - ▶ If you plan to offer one of the **new or redesigned** * AP courses for 2014–15, put an ‘**N**’ next to the course number. **These courses are not eligible for reauthorization.** Also put an ‘**N**’ next to the course number of a previously existing AP course your site will offer for the first time next year, or one that a teacher will teaching for the first time.

* Starting next year, AP Physics I: Algebra-Based, and AP Physics II: Algebra-Based, each representing a year’s worth of work, will replace the current one-year AP Physics B course. The district will implement AP Physics I in 2014–15, and AP Physics II in 2015–16. A completely revised AP US History course will also launch in 2014–15.

AP Course Audit Requirements and Deadlines:

All AP courses must be approved and/or authorized annually through the College Board AP Audit. It is the high school's responsibility to obtain AP Audit approval for the courses it offers each year. **An AP course cannot be added to a school's UC 'a-g' Course List unless its documented status in the school's AP Audit Account is: Approved/Authorized, Reauthorized, or Under Review.**

To ensure that required deadlines for AP courses are met, schools need to adhere to the following **2014-15 AP Audit Calendar** deadlines:

March 4—June 30, 2014: NEW AP COURSE SYLLABI SUBMISSION

Principals need to establish their site's 2014-15 AP Course Audit Account; finalize electronic Course Audit Forms for transmission with new AP course syllabi; and make sure teachers meet the end-of-June deadline for syllabi submission. First-time **teachers** of AP courses submit their original course syllabi to the audit, along with the required signed Course Audit Forms by **June 30** to ensure audit processing by the 'a-g' update deadline.

Please note: All schools teaching the new AP Physics I course must have their syllabi approved in order for the course to be added to the district-level list of approved 'a-g' courses, required for the courses to be get onto the individual sites' 'a-g' lists.

August 1—September 10, 2014: REAUTHORIZATION OF PREVIOUSLY APPROVED AP COURSES

Principals need to reauthorize previously approved AP courses for their school for the 2014-15 school year as early in August as possible, and remove from their AP Audit Account status page any teachers not teaching, or courses not being offered in 2014-15 (this can only be done by calling the AP Audit Helpline).

September 15, 2014: UC 'A-G' COURSE LIST UPDATE CYCLE CLOSES

AP courses approved by the audit after this date will not be included on a school's official 2014-15 UC 'a-g' Course List; however, they will continue to receive district weighted credit toward graduation. Students taking these courses may be disadvantaged in the college admissions process by the courses not being on their school's published UC 'a-g' list.

September 15—January 31, 2015: AP AUDIT COURSE REVIEWS CONTINUE

Schools whose courses fail to meet the deadline for inclusion on the school's 'a-g' list must still obtain AP Audit approval for the courses that will be taught in 2014-15. All course syllabi and related documents for courses needing approval must be submitted to the audit site by January 31, 2015. Courses that fail to obtain AP audit approval for the 2014-15 school year will have the "AP" designation removed from the course title and students taking the course will not receive district weighted credit. Instead, they will be given credit in the regular, non-weighted equivalent course in the subject.
