C-33 PREQUALIFICATION APPLICATION FOR DESIGN-BID-BUILD CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

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REQUEST FOR PREQUALIFICATION OF BIDDERS

As a condition of bidding and in accordance with the provision of Section 20111.5 of the California Public Contract Code, the district is requiring prequalification of all prime contractors and subcontractors with a C-33 license wishing to submit bids for any District exterior painting project where painting is the majority of the work. If a bidder is already prequalified with the District as a prime contractor or MEP subcontractor for projects over \$1M, has a C-33 license, and is interested in the painting projects, please email prequal@sandi.net stating that you want to be on the list of C-33 prequalified contractors and your company will be automatically prequalified.

Prospective bidders are required to submit a completed prequalification application at any time, or no later than 10 business days before the bid opening due date, in order to be prequalified for a specific painting project(s). If prequalified, the contractor will be placed on the prequalified list of C-33 contractors for a 12-month period. A new application shall be required each year by the anniversary date of initial qualification. In no case will prequalification remain in effect longer than one (1) year from the date of notice of prequalification. The District reserves the right to update or modify the prequalification application at any time, which may result in a different one being issued for any subsequent annual re-qualification.

The responses and attachments provided for this application will be the basis of qualifying a contractor. The District reserves the right to check other sources available. Omission of, or refusal to supply, requested information can result in automatic disqualification.

The application is <u>not</u> a public record and is <u>not</u> open to public inspection. All information provided will be kept confidential to the extent permitted by law. San Diego Unified School District reserves the right to reject any and all prequalification applications and to waive any irregularities in the information contained therein.

Each prequalification application must be signed <u>under penalty of perjury</u> by an individual who has the legal authority to bind the contractor on whose behalf that person is signing. If any information provided by a contractor becomes inaccurate, the contractor must immediately notify the awarding body and provide updated accurate information in writing and under penalty of perjury.

SUBMISSION OF COMPLETED APPLICATIONS

Email completed Prequalification Application to prequal@sandi.net along with the following documents:

- California Contractor's License
- Cal OSHA 300 logs for past 3 years
- Letter of Bondability: The bonding surety is required to be an authorized surety in the state of California with an A.M. Best Key Rating of A-:VII or better.
- Certificate of Insurance: A minimum \$2,000,000 per occurrence and \$4,000,000 aggregate combined comprehensive single limit liability insurance is required for all projects.
- Current Financial Statement

NOTIFICATION OF PREQUALIFICATION RESULT

Completed prequalification applications must be submitted no later than **10 days prior to bid opening due date** (in accordance with Public Contract Code 20111.6).

Contractors will be notified of their application status by email and prequalified contractors will be posted to a list on the District's website. Notification will be made as soon as possible, but no later than 5 days prior to bid opening.

PROCEDURE FOR APPEAL OF PREQUALIFICATION RESULTS

An appeal of prequalification results must be in writing (e-mail is not acceptable). The appeal must be filed and received by the Contracts Administration Supervisor, at the address below, not more than five (5) calendar days following the date of issuance of the District's letter of denial of prequalification; and the written appeal sets forth, in detail, all grounds for the appeal, including without limitation all facts, supporting documentation, legal authorities and argument in support of the grounds for the appeal; any matters not set forth in the written appeal shall be deemed waived. All factual contentions must be supported by competent, admissible and credible evidence.

Within thirty (30) days after receipt of the Contractor's request the District will call to order a three-member appeal panel made up of Facilities Planning and Construction management/supervisory staff or any other staff deemed qualified by the District. The Contractor and up to three (3) representatives are invited to appear in person to bring before the appeal panel any additional or new information; Contractor's testimony shall be limited to twenty (20) minutes. The panel shall advise the Contractor on the points where the application response has fallen below the minimum required number of points to qualify, and allow the Contractor to speak to the issues. The Contractor is then released from the meeting and the panel members shall come to consensus on whether or not to allow the Contractor to prequalify. The Contractor will be emailed notification of the appeal panel's decision within five (5) after the meeting.

If Contractor requests an appeals panel, they may not contact any District staff prior to and/or during the appeal process. Any contact with District staff may result in the Contractors prequalification being automatically denied without appeal.

If Contractor is not prequalified, they may not submit a new application for a period of one (1) year from date of the denial. If Contractor requests an appeal and loses the appeal, they may not submit a new application until one (1) year from date of the panel's written decision.

- 3. Contractor must have *completed* a minimum of two (2) directly (prime) contracted or subcontracted K-12 or Community College district *painting* projects in the State of California greater than \$250,000 within the last three (3) years.
- 4. Contractor must score a minimum of 80 points in SECTION 5 SCORED INTERVIEW QUESTIONS.

SECTION 5 - SCORED INTERVIEW QUESTIONS

The following questions will be used to interview randomly selected contacts from <u>at least</u> two (2) <u>completed painting</u> projects. If you performed work as a painting subcontractor on any or all of your listed projects, District will contact the general contractor for the project for the interview questions.

In the event you have performed any painting projects as a prime contractor to the SD Unified District within the last three (3) years, whether you listed them as a reference under SECTION 6 or not, District will choose one of the projects (if more than one has been performed) and will interview the inspector, project manager and/or construction manager for that project, regardless of size or dollar amount. This reference will serve as one of the two references contacted for the Contractor.

The District will conduct the interviews. No action on the contractor's part is necessary. These questions are included on the package given to the contractor for information only.

The highest possible score on any single project is 100 points. An average score of less than 80 points disqualifies a subcontractor from working on projects that are proposed by San Diego Unified School District.

- 1. Are there any outstanding stop notices, liens or claims by the contractor that are currently unresolved on contracts for which notices of completion are recorded? (10 points maximum maximum points awarded if none)
- 2. Please rate the contractor's performance regarding the amount of supervision required by the owner during execution of the project. (10 points maximum)
- 3. Please rate the contractor's performance in providing reports and other paperwork, including change order paperwork and scheduling updates in a timely manner. (10 points maximum)
- 4. Did the contractor finish their portion of the project on schedule? (10 points maximum)
- 5. Please rate the contractor's performance on the following factors:
 - a. Providing sufficiently experienced supervision over the project (10 points maximum).
 - b. Providing adequate on-hand supervision over their staff and subcontractors during Contract time (10 points maximum)
 - c. Adequately staffing the project (5 points maximum)
 - d. Providing sufficient equipment the to perform the work in a timely manner on the project (5 points maximum)
- 6. Did the contractor observe safety measures to adequately protect the surrounding environment and non-painted surfaces from paint overspray and hazardous chemicals, safely store on-site materials, and follow EPA guidelines for handling, storage and disposal of hazardous materials so as to not allow paint to reach storm drains and other environmentally sensitive areas? (10 points maximum)
- 7. Rate how the contractor performed in keeping the worksite clean during project time and job completion clean-up. (10 points maximum)
- 8. Was the contractor responsive and cooperative to the owner's needs and requests while performing the work? (10 points maximum)
